

# TOP TWENTY-ONE IPAD RULES

1. The iPad is to be used for education and research only. This applies to its use at school and at home.
2. Keep the iPad with you, in a classroom, or locked in your locker at all times. Do not leave your iPad in your backpack on the playground or in the hallways.
3. Do not let anyone use the iPad other than your parents or guardians.
4. The iPad is the property of the CUESD and may be inspected at any time. You should have NO expectations of privacy of materials found on the iPad.
5. The iPad can take photos and videos. Ask permission before recording an individual or group. Recordings and photos taken without permission are subject to disciplinary consequences.
6. Bring the fully charged iPad to school every day. Disciplinary consequences may be taken if a student has an uncharged iPad three times per trimester.
7. The lock screen (screen that appears when the iPad is powered on) must show your first and last name, photo, and homeroom teacher. It should be easy to read. The photo should clearly look like you.
8. You may choose your own wallpaper for the homescreen, but all images must be school appropriate. Inappropriate images include (but are not limited to) guns, weapons, inappropriate language, drug, alcohol, or gang activity.
9. All photos saved to the iPad photo library must be school appropriate and have an educational or research purpose.
10. You may not modify or delete any settings that change the network monitoring access. You may not clear your history at any time, nor may you enter "Private" mode.
11. Do not plug the iPad in to any computer at home or at school.
12. You do not have permission to access music streaming websites on the iPad. Music stored on the iPad may be listened to according to the rules of the classroom teacher.
13. Do not eat or drink while using the iPad.
14. You must keep the case on the iPad at all times. You are encouraged to purchase a padded sleeve case as well, which will help protect the iPad when it is in your backpack.
15. Do not put food or drink in your backpack if your iPad is there. Carry them separately.
16. Use the screen cleaning materials in each classroom when you need to clean the iPad. Do not use any other cloth (like your sleeve or a tissue).
17. Put your iPad in your backpack when you are going between classes.
18. You may not use your iPad (including listening to music) at school unless you are inside a classroom.
19. If there is a problem with your iPad, or if it is missing, you must tell a staff member immediately.
20. During class time, you can use the iPad when directed by the teacher, and you may only use the apps appropriate for the task.
21. All of the rules that are in effect during the school day extend to the use of the iPad at home.
